### The expected agenda for Saturday will be:

- Introduction to lanseo and its concepts
- Installing lanseo on a computer or laptop
- Pre Tournament Prep
  - Creating a shoot in lanseo and working through all the options that you need to set
  - Importing all your Archers into the shoot and creating Target Lists
  - Creating Teams and Awards
  - Printing Scoresheets
  - Optionally uploading your tournament to lanseo.net
- During Tournament
  - Inputting scores (if you are not using the PDAs)
  - Leaderboards during shooting
  - Printing results sheets for presentation
- After Tournament
  - Creating a Results Sheet
  - Paperwork for Archery GB (record status)

### A note from Tim:

As you can see this is a lot to cover. My intention is that the course will be classroom led by me, however there will be a lot of practical work during the day. Therefore, if at all possible, please bring a laptop. If you are able to come with lanseo pre-installed that will help us with time during the day, however I expect to help some of you with this task so that you have something to work on and also go home and continue to familiarise yourselves with lanseo.

If you do not have a laptop you can use on the day, be sure to let me know and we will try and provide one for you to use. lanseo is a web based application so we can run a couple of laptops from my server.

lanseo is relatively easy to install and can be downloaded from their website [www.ianseo.net](http://www.ianseo.net). Click on the download page and select the option you need. Don't worry if you get stuck. Leave it to the day.

The most likely option will be the full windows installer here.

There is also a user manual which you can look at, however PLEASE do not be put off by it. It's been written by one of the Italian guys in relatively poor English. You will also find that many of the terms used in the book, do not relate too well to the terms we use. Remember that lanseo is written mainly for World Archery rules and rounds and FITARCO (Italy) is heavily biased to this.
