**Drug testing:** This record status shoot will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Entries from archers under 18 must be signed by a parent/guardian to signify their consent to their child being drug tested if approached.

**Data:** When you enter competitions the following information may be collected: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability information. For example, this may be shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors and published on target lists and tournament results.
