Hicks Field, London Road, Bath, BA1 7DA

The RFC field is next to Bath Archers ground on London Rd West.

From M4 j18, follow A46 towards Bath. When you reach the large underpass on the dual carriageway, take the left turn towards Batheaston. Avon Rugby is on the right.

From the south, on the A36 follow the route through Bathampton,



over the narrow canal bridge to the Toll Bridge over the river Avon (80p). Up the hill and turn left at the mini roundabout. Avon Rugby is on the left (this sign is harder to see from this direction).
