<b>ROUNDS</b>	Ladies and Gents WA 1440 Round with World Record Status
<b>SHOOTING</b>	There will be three archers per boss shooting in a single detail 6 arrows per end in 4 mins for the two longer distances 3 arrows per end in 2 mins for 50m and 30m
<b>TIMINGS</b>	Equipment inspection from 09:00. Assembly at 09:30 which will be followed by 45 mins of practice.
<b>ENTRY FEE</b>	£17.00 - cheques payable to "Somerset County Archery Association".
<b>CLOSING DATE</b>	8th September 2019. As space is limited, early entry is advisable.
<b>LATE ENTRY FEE</b>	There will be a late entry fee of £3.00 per person
<b>JUNIORS</b>	Juniors may enter and will be eligible for awards but must shoot the appropriate senior round.
