ROUNDS	Open York/Hereford rounds for Championship, National round in afternoon, non championship
SHOOTING	There will be four archers per boss shooting in two details Timed 6 arrows per end in 4 mins for all rounds
TIMINGS	Equipment inspection from 09:30. Assembly at 10:00 which will be followed by sighters at 10:15. Shooting will follow on from sighters. National round to start at same time as Afternoon Hereford. Approx. 14:00
ENTRY FEE	York/Hereford Round - £14.00 National Round - £12.00 BACS payment via details on entry form Cheques payable to "Somerset County Archery Association"
CLOSING DATE	Monday 1st June 2020. As space is limited, early entry is advisable.
LATE ENTRY FEE	There will be a late entry fee of £4.00 per person
JUNIORS	Juniors may enter and will be eligible for awards but must shoot the appropriate senior round.
AWARDS	SCAA County and Open Awards for Ladies/Gents shooting Recurve, Compound, Longbow and Barebow according to entry
