ABLE BODIED ARCHERS	Please indicate in the “Additional Information” box on the entry form if you are NOT prepared to collect and/or score arrows for disabled archers.
DIRECTIONS TO VENUE	These can be found on the club’s website www.gordano-valley-archers.co.uk under the tab “Location”. Once in the school drive follow the signs to the car park outside the Sports Hall.
CAR PARKING	There is plenty of parking on site and the best one to use is adjacent to the Sports Hall and archery range. Please note there is no parking on the playing fields.
CHILDREN & PETS	Children must be supervised at all times to prevent disturbance to archers and their equipment. The venue is a school playing field so pets are not allowed on the field.
GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATIONS	<p>When you enter this tournament the following information will be collected and used within the record system: name, gender, bow style, age category (including date of birth), email, address, phone number, club, county, region, round, disability information.</p> <p>The following information will also be shared with other competitors and ArcheryGB and Northern Counties Archery Society in the form of target lists and results, name, gender, bow style, age category, club, county, region and round.</p>
DISABLED ARCHERS	Please use the “Additional Information” box on the entry form to let the TO know if you can move on and off of the line in the time allowed, if you are able to get to the target to help score and/or pull arrows and if you will be bringing an assistant/agent. Please note that mobile vehicles are welcome on the playing field but archers must be aware of the weather conditions and whether this may affect their mobility on the range.
EQUIPMENT	<p>Equipment checks will be carried out by the Judges prior to Assembly. Archers are responsible for ensuring their equipment meets the required standards for competition.</p> <p>Gordano Valley Archers or The Downs School cannot accept any responsibility for damaged arrows, other equipment or archer’s property, however caused.</p>
DRESS CODE	ArcheryGB dress code (Rule 307) applies and will be enforced. No denim or camo.
DRUG TESTING	Archers competing at record status tournaments will be liable for drug testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. Entries from archers under 18 must be acknowledged by a parent/guardian to signify their consent for a junior archer to be drug tested if approached. Please indicate consent using the relevant box on the entry form.
JUDGES	The Judge in Charge for this tournament will be John Cunningham.

- PHOTOGRAPHY** Photographs WILL be taken at this tournament for publicity and promotional purposes. Anyone NOT willing to be photographed during the tournament should not enter. Persons wishing to take photographs must register their intentions with the Tournament Organiser on the appropriate form available at the event.
- TENT LINE** There is ample space for tents on the tent line. Note there is no overnight camping.
- SPECTATORS** Spectators are welcome at any time but must comply with the safety arrangements and are on the field at their own risk.
- CATERING** Ann Davey and her team will be providing catering at breakfast and lunch time with afternoon teas and cakes. Please note Ann will try to cater for any dietary requirements - please indicate in the “Additional Information” box on the entry form if you would like her to try and cater for your requirements.
- TOILETS** These are available in the Sports Hall adjacent to the playing field and the Pavilion which is located on the playing field itself.
- TARGET LIST & RESULTS** These will be posted on the following websites:

- Archers who have provided a valid email address on their entry form will also receive a copy. If you require a hard copy this can be provided for a fee of £4.50 to cover stationary and postage or you can send a stamped address envelope.
- ENTRY FORM** Please complete the entry form on the back page of this prospectus and either post it to the Tournament Organiser or you can scan it and send it electronically to the email address for the Tournament Organiser.
- Payment can be made by cheque, made payable to “Somerset County Archery Association” with the hard copy of the entry form or by bank transfer. If using bank transfer method please use your ArcheryGB number followed by your surname eg 123456MAINES

- ENTRY – EARLY** Early entries are encouraged due to potential limited space. Entries are accepted on a “first come first serve” basis. There are no refunds or substitutions after the closing date.
- ENTRY – LATE** Late entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Organiser and will be subject to available space. Entries received after the closing date will be subject to a £3 surcharge. Changes to existing entries the surcharge will be waived.
