



### How to find us:



Above shows the Bath Archers Home Ground Entrance on London Road West. The yellow rectangle is the shooting ground. Signs will be placed by the entrance on the day.

#### From the North:

Follow A46 from M4 Junction 18 towards Bath.

When you reach the large underpass on the dual carriageway, take the left hand lane up to the roundabout.

At the roundabout turn left towards Batheaston.

Bath Archery is on the right.

#### From the South

On the A36 follow the route through Bathampton, over the narrow Canal Bridge. and proceed over the Toll Bridge over the river Avon (£1.00 toll).

Up the hill turn left at the mini roundabout;

The Bath Archers Ground is on the left.
