28 Archers expressed a preference to remain with the York and Hereford
38 Archers expressed a preference to change to Ladies and Gents 1440
2 Archers did not answer
6 Archers stated that they did not mind.

24 Archers expressed that they wanted to shoot 6 arrow ends all through the day

6 Archers expressed that they wanted multiple face setup at 50m and 30m
5 Archers expressed that they specifically wanted a single face at 50m and 30m. The majority of these were Longbow Archers.

6 Archers said they wanted to shoot on foam targets. They were not all Compound Archers.

Some specific comments that were written on the back of the scoresheets were:

A DCAS Gents Recurve – We should shoot a 50/70m ranking round and Team Head to Head

A DCAS and a DWAA Gents Recurve – We should shoot a 50/70m ranking round and Head to Head on Saturday and a 1440 on Sunday

A DWAA Gents Recurve - Said that no scores should be dropped

A SCAA Gents Recurve – Team Head to Head

Note that these Archers were all on the top few targets.

A DCAS Ladies Longbow – I am really torn between the two as I don't want us to lose the traditional as they are becoming fewer. If we have to go to a 1440 we should shoot 6 arrows, but Longbows have a full face in the afternoon.

A DWAA Gents Longbow – How about a separate GWAS Intercounties for Longbow and Barebow shooting York / Hereford. Recurve and Compound do a 1440.

A SCAA Ladies Recurve:

1440 – Negative points

- Earlier start
- Extra distance change

Efficient work party would be needed for these changes

Move to 3 Archers per boss, shooting 6 arrows all day. Otherwise it will take too long.

York/Hereford – Negative points

- Don't forget tradition
- Too many shoots switching to Metric rounds

York/Hereford – Positive points

- Later Start
- 1 Less Distance change

Don't forget that this is only the opinion of three out of the four counties in GWAS.
